c) A lorry driver travels about 370 miles per day for 5 days a week. To the nearest 1000, how many miles does the driver travel each week?

2,000

3) Thomas says to Mrs How:



6500 rounded to the nearest 1000 is 6000.

Do you agree or disagree with Thomas? Explain.

Thomas is incorrect because there is a 5 in the hundreds column so you must round up and not down.
